By submitting an entry, you agree to be bound by the following "Official Rules" of the contest:

1. SPONSOR

This contest is sponsored by the Travis County Elections Department

2. ELIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled in university or college in Travis County, Texas
- Employees and immediate family members of the Sponsor or members of their household are not eligible to participate

3. **HOW TO ENTER**

Designs may be submitted beginning on March 22, 2022. To enter, you must submit your artwork, "I Voted" Sticker Design Entry Form and Consent form electronically to stickercontest@traviscountytx.gov. All required forms and artwork must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 22, 2022. Late entries will not be accepted. A limit of two entries will be permitted per participant and no entry fee is required to participate in this contest. Should any questions arise, please email stickercontest@traviscountytx.gov.

4. <u>DESIGN REQUIREMENTS</u>

The design must include the phrase "I Voted" and contain the theme of voting and elections in the State of Texas or Travis County. The dimensions of the design should fit on a circular sticker two inches in diameter. The included template can be used. **Please keep the design limited to 4 colors or less.** The colors should be flat and the design should implement block shading when applicable with no gradient/transparent color schemes. To accommodate print quality, designs should be submitted as an email attachment to stickercontest@traviscountytx.gov. Be sure to include any fonts, support files (such as scans or logos). The files are accepted in the following formats:

- Adobe Illustrator (AI, PDF, EPS, AIT, SVG, SVGC)
- Adobe Photoshop (PSD, PSDC, PSB, PNG, JPEG, TIFF, HEIC)
- Adobe InDesign (INDD, PDF)

Important: PDF files are accepted, but we prefer the original files. Please be sure your PDF file is high-resolution quality art.

If you are submitting an EPS, TIFF, JPEG, BMP, or PNG files they must be a minimum of 600 pixels per inch for line art and type, or 300 pixel per inch for photographic images.

Please use spot color designs in Photoshop Spot Color channels (not layers), or use a vector illustration program like FreeHand or Illustrator. Files with transparency effects, please ensure that your document's raster effects settings are set to 300 pixel per inch output to ensure the best possible reproduction.

Microsoft Word, Publisher, PowerPoint documents, CorelDraw documents, low-resolution web images, WordPerfect documents or CAD drawings as artwork are not accepted.
