

AMENDMENT TO ORDER CALLING DIRECTOR ELECTION

WHEREAS, Wells Branch Municipal Utility District (the “District”) is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, operating under Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Order Calling Director Election adopted by the Board of Directors of the District (the “Board”) on July 21, 2020 (the “Order”) the Board ordered an election to be held on November 3, 2020 and authorized the form notice of the election (the “Notice”) required to be provided under the Texas Election Code;

WHEREAS, the Order and the Notice provide that early voting in the election by personal appearance will begin on Monday, October 19, 2020, and end on Friday, October 30, 2020, in accordance with the period for early voting by personal appearance required under Section 85.001(a) of the Texas Election Code;

WHEREAS, after the Order was adopted and notice of the election was provided, the Governor of the State of Texas issued a proclamation dated July 27, 2020 (the “Proclamation”) that temporarily suspended Section 85.001(a) of the Texas Election Code for any election ordered or authorized to be held on November 3, 2020 and extended the period for early voting by personal appearance for any such election;

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to amend the Order and the Notice to conform with the period for early voting by personal appearance set forth in the Proclamation;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE BOARD THAT:

Section 1. Section 3 of the Order is amended and restated as follows:

“Section 3. The Travis County regular early voting clerk is Dana DeBeauvoir. The Williamson County regular early voting clerk is Christopher J. Davis, Williamson County Elections Administrator. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted at the times, dates, and polling places established by Travis County and Williamson County for early voting, as set forth on the attached **Exhibits “A” and “B”**, respectively. The Travis County regular early voting clerk’s official address to which requests for applications for early voting ballots to be voted by mail may be sent is Travis County Early Voting Clerk – Elections Division, PO Box 149325, Austin, Texas 78714-9325, and the email address is ebbm@traviscountytexas.gov. The Williamson County regular early voting clerk’s official address to which requests for applications for early voting ballots to be voted by mail may be sent is Williamson County Elections, PO Box 209, Georgetown, Texas 78627-0209, and the email address is bbm@wilco.org.”

Section 2. The Secretary of the Board and the attorney for the District are directed to cause the amendment to notice of election in the form attached as **Exhibit “A”** to be published or posted in both English and Spanish in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Election Code.

Section 3. Except as specifically provided in this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Order will remain in full force and effect as amended hereby. In the event of

any inconsistency between the Order and this Amendment, this Amendment will control and modify the terms and provisions of the Order.

Section 4. This Amendment may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original and all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument. A facsimile or other electronic copy of a signature, and a counterpart transmitted electronically (e.g., by fax, email, text or similar means), will be deemed to be, and will have the same force and effect as, an original signature for all purposes.

AMENDMENT TO NOTICE OF DIRECTOR ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the period for early voting by personal appearance set forth in the previously provided Notice of Election (the "Original Notice") for the Wells Branch Municipal Utility District (the "District") November 3, 2020 directors election has been extended by proclamation of the Governor of the State of Texas. Accordingly, early voting in the election by personal appearance will be conducted at the times, dates, and polling places established by Travis County and Williamson County for early voting, as set forth in **Exhibit "3" and "4"**, respectively, to the Original Notice.

Except as specifically provided in this Amendment to Notice of Director Election ("Amendment"), all terms and conditions of the Original Notice will remain in full force and effect as amended hereby. In the event of any inconsistency between the Original Notice and this Amendment, this Amendment will control and modify the terms and provisions of the Original Notice.

LA ENMIENDA AL AVISO DE ELECCIÓN DE DIRECTOR

Se notifica por el presente que el periodo para la votación temprana mediante acto de presencia establecido en el Aviso de Elección provisto anteriormente (el “*Aviso Original*”) para la elección de directores del 3 de noviembre de 2020 del Distrito de Servicios Públicos Municipales de Wells Branch (el “*Distrito*”) se ha prolongado por la proclamación por el Gobernador del Estado de Texas. Por lo tanto, la votación temprana en la elección en persona se llevará a cabo en los horarios, fechas y lugares de votación establecidos por el Condado de Travis y Condado de Williamson para la votación temprana, como establecido en el **Anexo “3” y “4”** respectivamente, al Aviso Original.
