

ORDER BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS  
CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN SAID COUNTY;  
MAKING PROVISIONS FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING OF  
NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS  
RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court (the "Commissioners Court") of Travis County, Texas (the "County"), finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold a bond election for and within the County on the propositions hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court hereby finds and determines that said election shall be held on a uniform election date established by Section 41.001(a), Texas Election Code, as amended, as required by Texas law; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds, determines, and declares that the meeting at which this Order is considered is open to the public as required by law, and that the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given, as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The statements contained in the preamble of this Order are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Date; Propositions. A bond election (the "Election") shall be held for and within the County on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 ("Election Day"), a uniform election date established by Section 41.001(a), Texas Election Code, as amended (the "Code"), as required by Texas law. At the Election the following propositions (each, a "Proposition", and collectively, the "Propositions") shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the County in accordance with law:

TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS - PROPOSITION A

SHALL THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED UNDER ARTICLE III, SECTION 52, OF THE TEXAS CONSTITUTION TO ISSUE AND SELL, AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES AND IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR ISSUES, THE BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$233,060,000, MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE WITHIN 30 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND BEARING INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES (FIXED, VARIABLE, OR OTHERWISE), NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF MACADAMIZED, GRAVELED, OR

PAVED ROADS AND TURNPIKES, OR IN AID THEREOF, INCLUDING ACQUIRING LAND AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY THEREFOR, ROAD DRAINAGE, BIKE LANES, SIDEWALKS, AND SHARED USE PATHS, AND REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF ROAD BRIDGES AND CULVERTS, WITH RESPECT TO THE FOLLOWING ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS:

Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Projects

- Howard Lane/McNeil Road – add a shared use path from McNeil Drive to McNeil-Merriltown Road
- Active Transportation Safety Projects – add sidewalks, shared use paths, bike lanes, and signalization improvements to existing roadways

Roadway Capacity Projects

- Blake Manor Road – construction of a new 4 lane divided roadway from Taylor Lane to Burleson Manor Road
- Rowe Lane – construction of and improvements to existing roadway and the addition of a shared use path from SH130 to Hodde Lane
- Cameron Road – construction of a new 4 lane divided roadway and addition of a shared use path from Pecan Street to Fuchs Grove Road
- Arterial A – construction of a new 4 lane divided roadway with sidewalks and bike lanes
- Bee Creek Road – construction of and improvements to existing roadway and the addition of a shared use path from Lakehurst Road to Highland Boulevard
- South Pleasant Valley Road – construction of a new 4 lane divided roadway with bike lanes and sidewalks from Bradshaw Road to SH45
- Pyramid Drive – construction of and improvements to existing roadway and addition of sidewalks
- O'Reilly Drive – construction of and improvements to existing roadway and addition of sidewalks
- TxDOT Right-of-Way – right-of-way for State road projects,

AND IN PROVIDING FOR THE ABOVE PROJECTS, THE COMMISSIONERS COURT SHALL HAVE THE DISCRETION TO PRIORITIZE SUCH PROJECTS AND TO APPLY BOND AUTHORIZATION IN ACCORDANCE

WITH SUCH PRIORITY, AND TO LEVY TAXES, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY ANNUALLY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS IT ACCRUES AND TO CREATE A SINKING FUND TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF THE BONDS AS IT MATURES?

TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS - PROPOSITION B

SHALL THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL, AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES AND IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR ISSUES, THE BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$276,440,000, MATURING SERIALY OR OTHERWISE WITHIN 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND BEARING INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES (FIXED, VARIABLE, OR OTHERWISE), NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE, FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTING AND IMPROVING COUNTY PARKS AND THE ACQUISITION OF LAND AND INTERESTS IN LAND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, INCLUDING THE ACQUISITION OF OPEN SPACE PARK LAND, AND THE ACQUISITION OF CONSERVATION EASEMENTS FOR AUTHORIZED PURPOSES IN CONNECTION WITH OR FOR THE BENEFIT OF COUNTY PARKS, WITH RESPECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS:

Parks

- Strategic Parkland Acquisition – acquire land or interests in land for parks purposes along existing greenway corridors and in the Post Oak Savannah and Springs, Lake Travis (and adjoining watersheds), Cow Creek, Gilleland Creek, Onion Creek, Wilbarger Creek, Pedernales River, and Colorado River areas
- Onion Creek Greenway – construction of greenway trails and amenities from the SH183 trailhead West to McKinney Falls State Park and East to Moya Park
- Gilleland Creek Greenway – construction of greenway trails and amenities from Northeast Metro Park to and including improvements to Ben E. Fisher Park
- Arkansas Bend Park Phase III – construction of a group building and associated site improvements
- Bee Creek Sports Complex – construction of synthetic sports fields, a pavilion, and walking trails
- Southeast Metro Park Improvements – construction of 4 synthetic sports fields

Conservation Easements

- Execute conservation easement agreements on land in connection with and for the benefit of County parks for any authorized purposes, including to retain or protect or assure its availability for agricultural, recreational, or open-space use, protect natural and cultural resources, or maintain or enhance air or water quality,

AND IN PROVIDING FOR THE ABOVE PROJECTS, THE COMMISSIONERS COURT SHALL HAVE THE DISCRETION TO PRIORITIZE SUCH PROJECTS AND TO APPLY BOND AUTHORIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH PRIORITY, AND TO LEVY TAXES, WITHIN THE LIMITS PRESCRIBED BY LAW, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY ANNUALLY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS IT ACCRUES AND TO CREATE A SINKING FUND TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF THE BONDS AS IT MATURES?

Section 3. Official Ballot.

(a) Voting at the Election, and early voting for the Election, shall be by the use of the County's lawfully approved voting systems and ballots.

(b) The preparation of the necessary equipment and the official ballots for the Election shall conform to the requirements of the Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the Propositions which shall be set forth on the ballots substantially in the following form:

Section 4. Multilingual Election Materials. All notices, instructions, and ballots pertaining to the Election shall be furnished to voters in English and Spanish in compliance with the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended (the “Voting Rights Act”), and the Code, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 5. Persons Qualified to Vote. All resident, qualified voters of the County shall be eligible to vote at the Election.

Section 6. Election Precincts, Voting Locations, and Voting Hours on Election Day. The polling places for the Election are hereby designated to be those locations identified by Dyana Limon-Mercado, the Travis County Clerk (the “County Clerk”). Voting on Election Day shall be conducted at the countywide polling locations designated on Exhibit A attached hereto, with such locations being incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof for all purposes; provided, however, such locations may be changed if so directed by the County Clerk without further action by the Commissioners Court and without amendment of this Order. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to make such changes in precinct numbers and polling locations as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the Election, without further action by the Commissioners Court and without amendment of this Order, and the County Judge or his designee is hereby authorized to update Exhibit A to reflect the locations designated by the County Clerk, which locations are hereby approved. Each polling place shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Section 7. Early Voting Clerk; Early Voting Locations, Dates, and Times. (a) The County Clerk is hereby appointed as Early Voting Clerk for the election. Deputy early voting judges/clerks will be appointed as needed to process early voting mail and to conduct early voting. Early voting by mail shall be conducted in conformance with the requirements of the Code. The County Clerk is hereby authorized to appoint the members of the Early Voting Ballot Board and the presiding judges and alternate judges in accordance with the requirements of the Code and/or by separate order of the Commissioners Court. Early voting shall be conducted by the Early Voting Clerk, at the main early voting polling location listed below; provided, such location may be changed or additional early voting locations may be added by the County Clerk, without further action of the Commissioners Court and without amendment of this Order, as is necessary for the proper conduct of the Election.

(b) The address for the Early Voting Clerk and the address for application for ballot by mail is Dyana Limon-Mercado, Travis County Elections, P.O. Box 149325, Austin, Texas 78714-9325, and the Early Voting Clerk may be reached at the following: (i) Telephone: (512) 238 - 8683, (ii) Email: [elections@traviscountytexas.gov](mailto:elections@traviscountytexas.gov), and (iii) Website: <https://countyclerk.traviscountytexas.gov/departments/elections>.

(c) Applications for early voting in the County by mail shall be submitted to the Travis County Elections, P.O. Box 149325, Austin, TX 78714-9325, or in person by the individual voter or by common or contract carrier to Travis County Election Division, 5501 Airport Blvd, Suite #100, Austin, TX 78751-1410. Applications for voting by mail must be received (not post-marked) no later than the close of business (5:00 p.m. Central Time) on October 27, 2023.

(d) The main early voting polling place for the County is hereby designated to be the City of Austin Permitting & Development, located at 6310 Wilhelmina Delco Drive, Austin, Texas 78752.

(e) Early voting by personal appearance for all election precincts shall be held at the locations, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein, or at such other locations, times, and days as hereafter may be designated by the County Clerk, without further action by the Commissioners Court and without amendment of this Order. The County Judge or his designee is hereby authorized to update Exhibit A to reflect the locations and times designated by the County Clerk, and such locations are hereby approved.

(f) The Early Voting Clerk is hereby authorized to appoint the members of the early voting ballot board and the presiding judges and alternate judges for each polling location in accordance with the requirements of the Code. Each of the presiding judges shall be authorized to approve the necessary election clerks to assist in conducting the Election.

(g) Voting times may be changed if so directed by the County Clerk without further action of the Commissioners Court and without amendment of this Order. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to make such changes in voting hours as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the Election.

Section 8. Notice of Election. Notice of the Election shall be given by: (i) publishing a substantial copy of this Order, in English and Spanish, two times on the same day in consecutive weeks, with the first publishing not earlier than the thirtieth day or later than fourteen days prior to the date set for the Election, in a newspaper published in the County, or, in the absence of such newspaper, in a newspaper of general circulation within the County (or that otherwise complies with applicable law), (ii) posting a copy of this Order and the Voter Information Documents (as hereinafter defined), in English and Spanish, in the County courthouse on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the Commissioners Court and in at least three other public places within the boundaries of the County, not later than the twenty-first day prior to the date set for the Election, and (iii) posting a copy of this Order and the Voter Information Documents, in English and Spanish, on the County's website, prominently and together with the notice of the Election, the contents of the Propositions and any sample ballot prepared for the election, not later than the twenty-first day prior to the date set for the Election through Election Day. Additionally, on Election Day and during early voting by

personal appearance, this Order and the Voter Information Documents shall be posted in a prominent location at each polling place. Notice of the Election shall also be posted to the County's internet website not later than the twenty-first day before the election, in compliance with Section 4.009, Texas Election Code, as amended. The website for the County can be found at <https://www.traviscountytx.gov>.

Section 9. Conduct of Election. The Election shall be held in accordance with the Code, the Texas Government Code, and the Voting Rights Act, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 10. Information Required by Section 3.009 of the Election Code.

(a) County's Outstanding Debt. As of the date of this Order, the County's aggregate principal amount of outstanding tax-supported debt was \$900,550,000, and the aggregate amount of outstanding interest on such tax-supported debt was \$264,289,150. As of the date of this Order, the County's ad valorem debt service tax rate for the current fiscal year is \$0.039318 per \$100 of assessed valuation.

(b) Issuance of New Debt. The County intends to issue the bonds authorized by the Propositions in a manner and in accordance with a schedule to be determined by the Commissioners Court based upon a number of factors, including, but not limited to, the then-current needs of the County, demographic changes, prevailing market conditions, assessed valuations of property in the County, and management of the County's short-term and long-term interest rate exposure. Market conditions, demographics, and assessed valuations of property vary based upon a number of factors beyond the County's control; therefore, the County cannot and does not guarantee a particular interest rate or tax rate associated with the bonds authorized by the Propositions. As such, the information contained in this paragraph is provided solely for illustrative purposes and does not establish any limitations or restrictions or create a contract with the voters. The County estimates that, based on the County's current taxable assessed valuation, current market conditions as of the date of this Order, and estimated future growth in the County's taxable assessed valuation, if the Propositions are approved and all of the bonds authorized by the Propositions are issued in accordance with the County's current projected plan of finance, the maximum interest rate on the bonds is not expected to exceed 5.00%.

(c) Additional Information Required by Section 3.009 of the Code. The additional information required by Section 3.009 of the Code is located in Sections 2 and 3 of this Order.

Section 11. Voter Information Documents. The Commissioners Court hereby approves the voter information documents (the "Voter Information Documents"), in substantially the form presented to the Commissioners Court, with such changes as may be approved by the County Judge, or his designee, acting on behalf of the Commissioners Court, in consultation with the County Attorney, bond counsel, and financial advisor, as prescribed by Section 1251.052(b), Texas Government Code.

The County Judge, or his designee, acting on behalf of the Commissioners Court, is further authorized and directed to post or provide for the posting of the Voter Information Documents in the manner provided under Section 8 of this Order, and additionally on the County's website in an

easily accessible manner beginning not later than the twenty-first day before the date set for the Election and ending on the day after Election Day.

Section 12. Conservation Easement Determinations. If Proposition B is approved by County voters, the Commissioners Court will make a determination at the time it authorizes any bonds to be issued pursuant to Proposition B for the purposes of acquiring conversation easements that the conservation easements to be acquired with proceeds of such bonds are in connection with or for the benefit the County's parks.

Section 13. Necessary Actions. The County Judge and the County Clerk, or such person's designee, acting on behalf of the Commissioners Court, in consultation with the County Attorney and bond counsel are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of the Code and the Voting Rights Act in carrying out and conducting the Election, whether or not expressly authorized herein, including making changes or additions to polling places or procedures to the extent required or desirable as determined by the County Clerk or as may become necessary due to circumstances arising after the date of this Order.

Section 14. Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Order, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, neither the remaining portions of this Order nor their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall be affected thereby, it being the intent of the Commissioners Court in adopting this Order that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, invalidity, or unenforceability of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Order are declared to be severable for that purpose.

Section 15. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
